

## UKSPA Cambridge October 2018

### Transport and Accommodation

Cambridge is easily accessible by road (M11/A14), mainline rail stations and air – Stansted Airport is a 40 minute train journey from Cambridge North.

[Cambridge Science Park](#): CB4 0FZ

Road: The Park is located next to J33 of the A14 and about 10 minutes drive from the M11.

Rail: The Park is served by 2 train stations – Cambridge North and Cambridge Rail: main station – with good rail links from London, the Midlands and the East/West coast main line service.

It is anticipated that most delegates will use the coach service provided to and from the Wellcome Genome Campus (with cars left overnight at Cambridge Science Park) but for those wishing to make their own way there:

Road: The campus is located close to the M11 – if arriving from the North exit at Junction 10, If arriving from the South exit at Junction 9.

Rail: The campus' closest station is Whittlesford Parkway on the main line between Cambridge and London Liverpool St. There is no taxi rank however and [taxi booking](#) is advised.

### Accommodation

The conference hotel is Mulberry Court - [Hinxtion Hall](#) at the Wellcome Genome Campus CB10 1RQ.
